Contact, as defined herein, shall include but shall not be limited to personal contact, contact by telephone, written correspondence including electronic mail [e-mail] and/or instant messaging, or by delivery or causing to be delivered any items, materials, communication or packages of any kind whatsoever; or facilitating, causing, engaging, encouraging or requesting the use of third-party intermediaries excluding counsel of record, or by any other means of communication.

Violation of a Protective Order as defined by *Kansas Statutes Annotated 2004 Supp. 21-3843* and amendments thereto is a Class A misdemeanor.
